



Scholarship Guidelines

SCHOLARSHIP OVERVIEW

- The Down Syndrome Association of Greater Toledo (DSAGT) provides a one-time-per-calendar year \$100 scholarship to benefit an individual with Down syndrome who is interested in attending a camp, recreational, therapeutic or educational activity of their choice.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Individuals with Down syndrome of all ages are eligible to receive DSAGT Scholarship funds.
- The individual with Down syndrome and their family must be members of DSAGT and live within the Northwest Ohio and Southern Michigan service-area counties to receive scholarship funds.
- Siblings of individuals with Down syndrome do not qualify.
- The camp or activity attended does not have to be located in the Greater Toledo area.
- See “Timeline” for Scholarship Program timeline and deadlines.

TIMELINE

- June 30 – Scholarship application deadline
- Months of April/May/June/July – After activity enrollment/intended participation has been verified and payment has been made directly to the activity provider, DSAGT staff or representative will notify family of payment.
- If the timeline does not coincide with activity registration deadline, we will reimburse the family for the camp/activity if a receipt or proof of payment is provided.

APPLICATION SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- All applications will be directed to information@dsagt.org or the DSAGT mailing address listed at the bottom of the application.
- Should parents choose to unenroll their child in the camp or activity for which a scholarship application has been filled out, DSAGT should be alerted by emailing information@dsagt.org or calling 419-536-4321.

DSAGT PROMOTION OF SCHOLARSHIPS FOR PR/FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

- If a \$100 scholarship is issued on behalf of the applying individual/family, DSAGT asks that the individual or family submits a photo (or photos) of activity participation for use in newsletter, website, social media, marketing materials, grant/funding proposals and more
- Should self-advocates, parents or caregivers wish for photos to be exempt from any website or social media marketing use, we ask that a short story of their experience be shared.
